Definitions **Vaqueros** shoot the match with one (1) Centaure percussion revolver or one (1) Centaure conversion respectively, in addition to shotgun and rifle subject to their chosen category. To enable as many shooters as possible to participate in the shoot,
Hacienderos shoot the match with two (2) percussion revolvers or two (2) conversions/Open Tops respectively, in addition to their shotgun and rifle.
In 1870 and/or Frontiersman one (1) revolver must be a Centaure percussion revolver.
In 1875 and/or Frontier Cartridge Duelist conversion revolvers are required (Centaure conversions are desired)
A few Centaure percussion revolvers & Centaure conversions can be borrowed at the range. Please, indicate your needs on your registration form.
No Colt SAAs, Remington 1875s, S&W Schofields, Ruger Vaqueros etc. are allowed!

- Guns** in accordance with the rules set forth in the BDS Westernschießen Shooters Handbook
Revolvers: check definitions on previous page
Shotgun: subject to the category chosen 20 to 12 ga., side-by-side w/o automatic ejector, lever or slide action of models through 1897
Lever/slide action rifle/carbine: subject to the category chosen .32 to .45 pistol cal., tube magazine holding at least 10 rounds, outside hammer
- Ammunition** in accordance with the rules set forth in the BDS Westernschießen Shooters Handbook: pistol cartridges with lead bullets only, max. energy 1500 joule! No semi- or full metal jacket bullets. Every shooter is responsible for his reloaded cartridges. Soft lead balls or conicals only to be loaded into percussion revolvers.
BP ammo may be obtained on July 15, 2018 on site in .38 Special, .44 Colt, .44-40, .45 Colt cal. & 12/70 ga.. You may want to order in advance (!) from FROCS #30 Michael "Socks" Mayer at Lederstrumpf@gmx.eu. You are kindly requested to return your empties to Socks after the match.
- Open carry** on July 15, 2018 on the site of **Pulverfass in Radebeul**, Radebeul.
- Ammo needs** a minimum of 40 rounds each for revolvers and rifle/carbine, 30 rounds+ of shotgun ammo.
- Safety** safety glasses and hearing protection are mandatory for shooters, ROs, non-shooters and guests, shooting glasses are not allowed.
- Zero alcohol** for shooters & ROs during the shoot.
- Outfit** typical Western in accordance with the rules set forth in the BDS Western Shooters Handbook.
- Food/Beverages** in the restaurant of **Pulverfass in Radebeul**, Radebeul.
- House rules** By registering for the event every shooter, participant and/or guest acknowledges that the organizers and their representatives cannot be made responsible for any damages or injuries incurred during the event unless caused by purpose. Shots fired by the shooter and/or his/her equipment are his/her sole responsibility. Attending the shoot is at shooters', participants' and/or guests' own risk. The safe storage of his/her guns ist the shooter's sole responsibility. The shooters agree to accept helper chores during the shoot. By his/her registration shooters, participants and/or guests agree to the processing, digital storage of their person related data, pictures and match results and the publishing thereof.
